

### Unemployment Rate




Unemployment rates listed for Manhattan, Lawrence, Topeka, and Wichita are a measure of the entire Metropolitan Statistical Area.



### Metropolitan Statistical Area Population




## Median Sales Price


## Building Permits ~ Residential Housing Units

## Foreclosure Filings




### Riley County Foreclosures:

 The outcome of each specific filing in Riley County is unknown.



### Moody's Bond Rating

Ratings are assessed on the following factors: economy, debt structure, financial condition, demographics, and management practices of the governing body and administration.

"Aaa" - Best Quality

"Aa" - High Quality by all standards;

"A" - Upper medium grade

"Baa" - Medium grade obligations; they are neither highly protected nor poorly secured.
