1. Consider the minutes from October 24th, 2016 meeting.

Tross moved to approve the minutes as written. West seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

2. Landmark Water Tower Recommendation.

The Board discussed submitting a nomination of Landmark Water Tower to the Register of Historic Kansas Places, the National Register of Historic Places, and the Manhattan (Local) Register of Historic Places after volunteer research was submitted to City Administration. The Board determined the research was substantial enough for a complete nomination in all three registries.

Mattingly-Ebert made a motion, recommending the nomination of the Landmark Water Tower to the State and National Register of Historic Places, requesting the Manhattan City Commission to express support of such action and direct city staff to prepare and submit a nomination to the State Historic Preservation Office and the City of Manhattan for the local register. West seconded. Motion passed 6-0.

3. Updates and Announcements.

Chmiel updated the board on the status of the Sunset Area Historic survey, noting the HPF grant funding the survey would be applied for in mid February.
