

Weeds, Tall Grass, Trees and Shrubs

The following information details the requirements for mowing and removal of weeds, along with trimming of trees/shrubs, within the city limits of Manhattan.

- All grass, weeds and obnoxious vegetable growths on any lot or piece of land, including the right-of-way adjacent to said property and all easements shall be mowed and maintained to a height not to exceed 12 inches.
 - The right-of-way generally is that area from the front property line all the way to the street curb. Easements are areas usually for utilities and may be in back of or alongside your property lines.
 - Trees, shrubs and hedges growing on said property shall be trimmed in a manner not to obstruct or interfere with streets, alleys or sidewalks adjacent to said property.
 - Failure to maintain any lot or piece of land as prescribed herein is considered a nuisance and may result in action by the city, which may include abatement and billing of the property owner.

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
