Agency Deliberations:

The Board began their funding deliberations and had discussions regarding each agency on the amount of funding request, the expansion of services, and the need of the agency based upon cuts from other funding sources that the agencies have.

The total increase for 2011 funding allocation recommendations is 1.9% higher than the 2010 budgeted allocations. The Board is comfortable with this increase and feels they have sufficient reasons to suggest the increase to the City Commission. The Board allocated one increase to KSU Child Development Center due to the fact that childcare is such an important issue in our community, and KSU Child Development Center has worked with SSAB over the past several years and has proven appropriate use of the monies. All other agencies were allocated monies at or near their 2010 funding amounts. Three Rivers, a new agency, was not funded this year due to lack of monies available.

Debbie will draft a memo to all agencies requesting 2011 funding explaining the Board's recommendation and alerting those agencies of the work session date for outside agencies.
