

CEMETERY ADVISORY BOARD

The following members of the Cemetery Advisory Board were present: Ms. Judy Atwood, Mr. Patrick Gormely, Mr. Lawrence Pollack, Mr. Dennis Irvin, Mr. Stephen Konz and Ms. Deborah Saroff. Mr. Eric Londeen was absent. Also present at this meeting were Mr. Curt Loupe, Director of Parks and Recreation, Mr. Mike Mohler, Cemetery Sexton, and Mrs. Buffy Woodward, Administrative Assistant.

Mr. Gormely called the meeting to order.

MINUTES

It was moved by Mr. Pollack, seconded by Ms. Saroff to approve the minutes. On vote, motion carried 6-0.

SEXTON'S ANNUAL REPORT

Mr. Mohler explained that revenue for Sunset Cemetery in 2009 was \$9,600; revenue for Sunrise Cemetery in 2009 was \$61,850. As of March 1, 2010, revenue for Sunrise and Sunset Cemeteries was \$6,200.

On April 6, the purchase of two new mowers for Sunrise Cemetery will be going before the City Commission for approval. Two old ones will be traded in. The new mowers will be used primarily just for mowing.

The Sunrise Cemetery project of filling in the draws is on-going. Some fill dirt from the City Park Pool excavation has been brought over. Mr. Mohler has been working with the Park Planner on the layout of the Sunrise Cemetery over the next few years. In the near future, City Administration will start putting markers in sections K1 and K2. Discussion was held.

The meeting was adjourned. It was determined that the next meeting would be held on Thursday, June 17, 2010.
