1. KSU Design Days

The BAC reviewed student presentations beginning at 4:30 pm. Members then reconvened to discuss and review Design Days projects.

2. Dave Colburn moved to approve of July Meeting Minutes, Markle second the motion.

The minutes were approved by vote of seven to zero in favor.

3. Discussion of the City Staff Report

There was minimal current information for updates. There was a discussion of a future pedestrian route from Marlatt Avenue to Casement Road along the existing easement. Colburn asked who will design McCall Road from Hayes to Fourth Street and was concerned about crossing Tuttle Creek Boulevard. Dave asked about writing up a "Cycling 101" for the K-State Collegian and Manhattan Mercury. The numerous recent cycling-related letters in the paper could be an opportunity for education.

4. Bicycle Master Plan- Chad Bunger

Chad Bunger, City Planner, presented his Master's Thesis of a Bicycle Master Plan for the City of Manhattan. There was a discussion of "Bike Boxes" that could be initially installed on Claflin Avenue through campus and on North 11th street. Bunger will provide slides to Robert Ott, City Engineer, for future Bicycle Advisory Committee access.

5. KSU Design Days

There was an extended discussion about the student projects from KSU Design Days.
