Each agency will have a maximum of 20 minutes to meet with the Special Alcohol Fund Advisory Committee. The first 15 minutes will be the agency’s opportunity to address the following items (NOTE: Do not prepare a PowerPoint presentation):

- \* Briefly state why your agency should receive Special Alcohol funding for 2022
- \* State specifically how your agency will use Special Alcohol Funding for 2022
  - \* Provide your agency’s current evaluation results of services specifically supported by 2021 Special Alcohol funds or how your agency/organization will conduct an evaluation of services supported in 2021
  - \* Other information important to the Committee’s funding decision.
- \*Prepare to answer the following questions pertaining to COVID-19 Pandemic Funding:  
Did you receive Federal, State, or Local funds in 2020 related to the COVID-19 Pandemic?  
If so, how much of the funds can be used for NON-CV19 purposes?  
And for what NON-CV19 purposes were they/will they be used?

Have you applied for CV19 relief funds in 2021 that can be used for NON-CV19 purposes?  
If so, how much of the application funds can be used for NON-CV19 purposes?  
If granted, what will you use this portion of the funds for?

Following the Agency’s remarks, 5 minutes will then be allowed for questions from the Committee members.
