- The permit holder agrees to reimburse the City for any damage to the city street or alley caused by the dumpster at the rate of 1.5 times the costs to the City for labor and materials.
- This permit must comply with the following Special Site Conditions:
 - The dumpster must be relocated or removed as soon as practical, at the permit holder's expense, if in the opinion of the City Engineer (or designee), the dumpster is interfering with public safety or emergency services.

The Public Works Director's decision may be appealed by filing a written appeal with the City Manager within ten days of the Director's decision. The City Manager's decision shall be issued in writing and shall be considered final.
