

The 2021 Allocation of a Property Tax Dollar

The mill levy rate for the City of Manhattan is 49.835 and is distributed as follows:

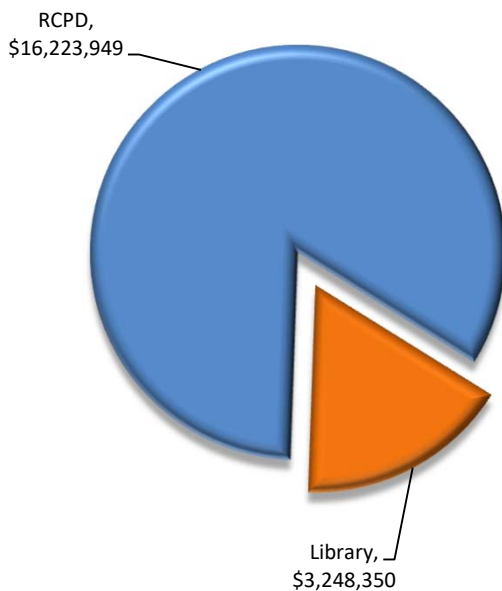
Based on the 2021 City Budget adopted by the City Commission, the City of Manhattan is responsible for only **32¢** of every \$1.00 paid in local property taxes by homeowners and businesses. Of this amount, about **11¢** are for day-to-day city operations under the direction of the City Manager.

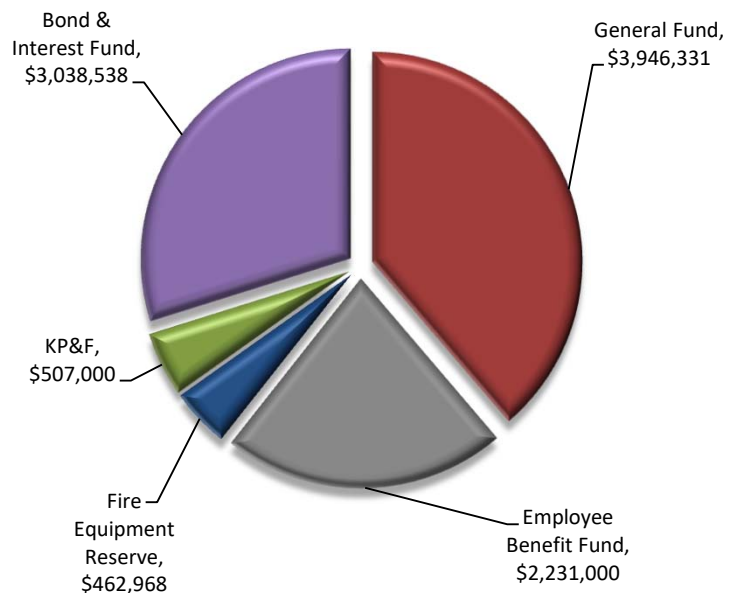
Property Taxes for 'Outside' City Services

A total of **\$29,658,136** will be levied in property taxes for the 2021 City Budget. Of this amount, **\$10,185,837** will be used to fund city operations, including debt service. **\$19,472,299** will be paid to other city services that are not under the direct control of the City Manager.
