Please set your sprinklers and water your grass on

TUESDAY, THURSDAY & SUNDAY.

Water demand is highest in the summer months and most people water on Monday/Wednesday/Friday. Making this simple change will help take strain off the system and ensure that there is plenty of water for all. Thank you for your help.



MOWING & TRIMMING

All grasses and weeds must be kept below 12 inches in height, per City of Manhattan Code of Ordinances.

Remember, you are responsible for mowing the rights of way (between the curb and sidewalk) and easements (outside fences and in alleys) on your property.

Your neighbors will appreciate it if you:

- Take the time to trim the curb line and sidewalks
- Control weeds
- Remove leaves and brush that could harbor unwanted critters

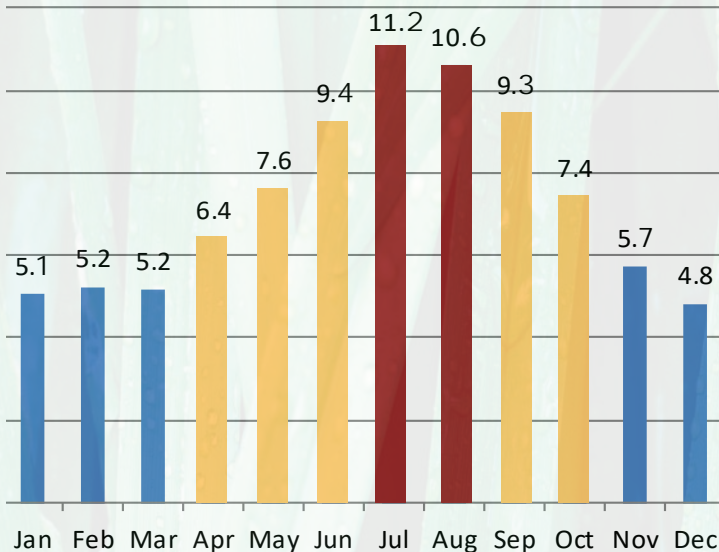

REMINDER: MANDATORY TEST FOR BACKFLOW PREVENTERS

City regulations require all lawn sprinkler systems to have a backflow preventer to protect the public water supply from possible contamination.
