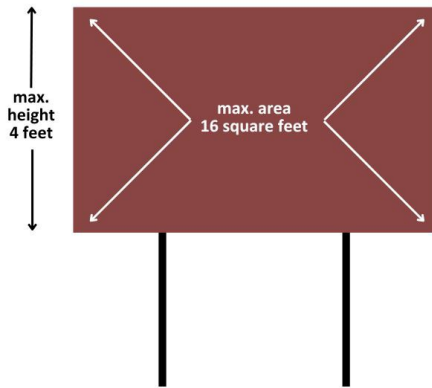


## SIZE AND TYPE OF SIGNS

Political signs must:

- be unlighted;
- not be permanently affixed to the ground, a building or other structure;
- have sign face gross area of no more than 16 square feet;
- have sign face height of no more than 4 feet.



## REMOVAL OF SIGNS

Signs posted in violation of the MDC within City or KDOT right-of-way are subject to immediate removal by the City. City staff will notify the candidate associated with the sign of the removal and hold the removed sign(s) for ten calendar days.

The person, party, or parties responsible for the placement or distribution of a political sign are responsible for its removal.

## POLITICAL SIGNS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF MANHATTAN

Political signs can only be posted within the Manhattan city limits for 45 days before and 2 days after an election. The 2023 “election period” is from September 23 until November 9.

During the election period, political signs may be posted within the city limits on private property, and within City right-of-way subject to the restrictions in the Manhattan Development Code (MDC).

Prior to September 23, 2023 and after November 9, 2023, no political signs may be posted within the city limits.



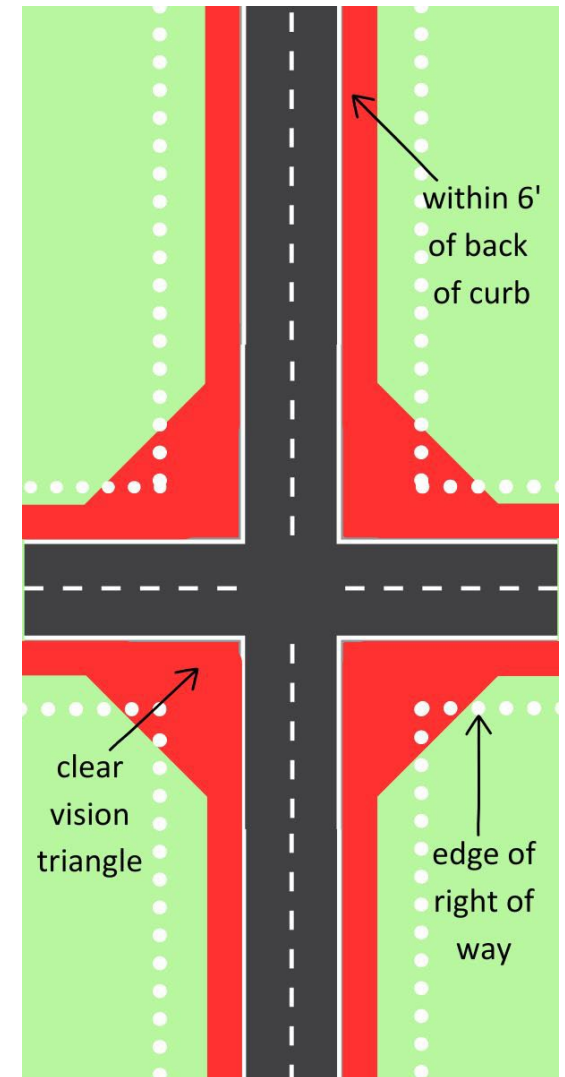
## POLITICAL SIGNS PROHIBITED IN CERTAIN LOCATIONS



Even during the election period, signs **may not be posted:**

1. within 6 feet from the back of the curb in City right-of-way;
2. on a paved portion of City right-of-way;
3. within a center median or roundabout in City right-of-way;
4. within a clear-vision triangle, or in any location that creates a safety hazard;
5. in right-of-way adjacent to City property, e.g. along Poyntz adjacent to the southern border of City Park;
6. on City property, e.g. grounds of City Hall or within a park; or
7. in KDOT right-of-way, e.g. Seth Child Rd. (Hwy 113), Fort Riley Blvd. (Hwy 18), Tuttle Creek Blvd/E. Poyntz Ave (Hwy 24).
