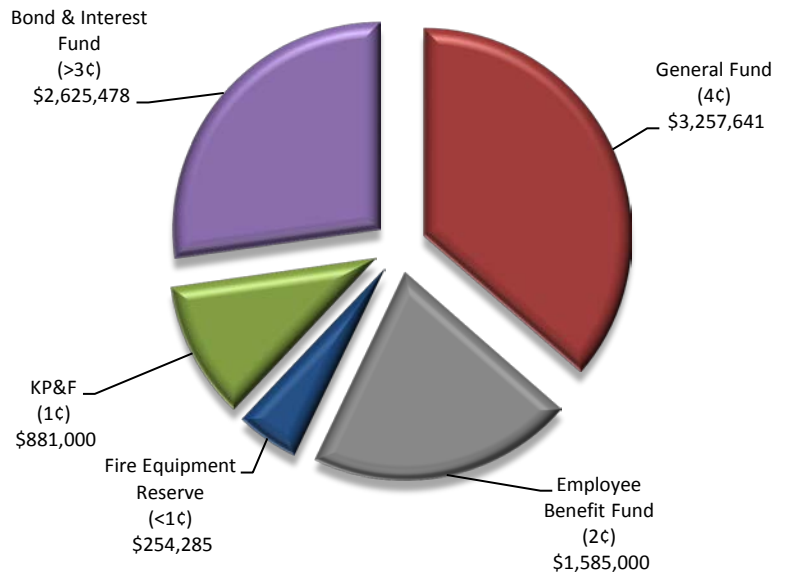
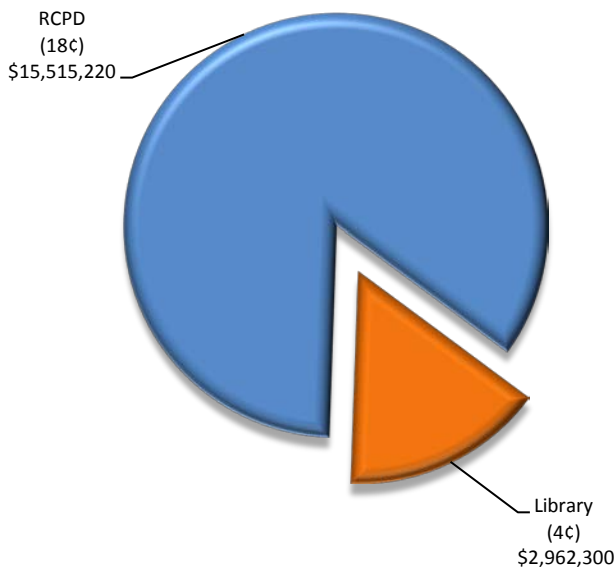
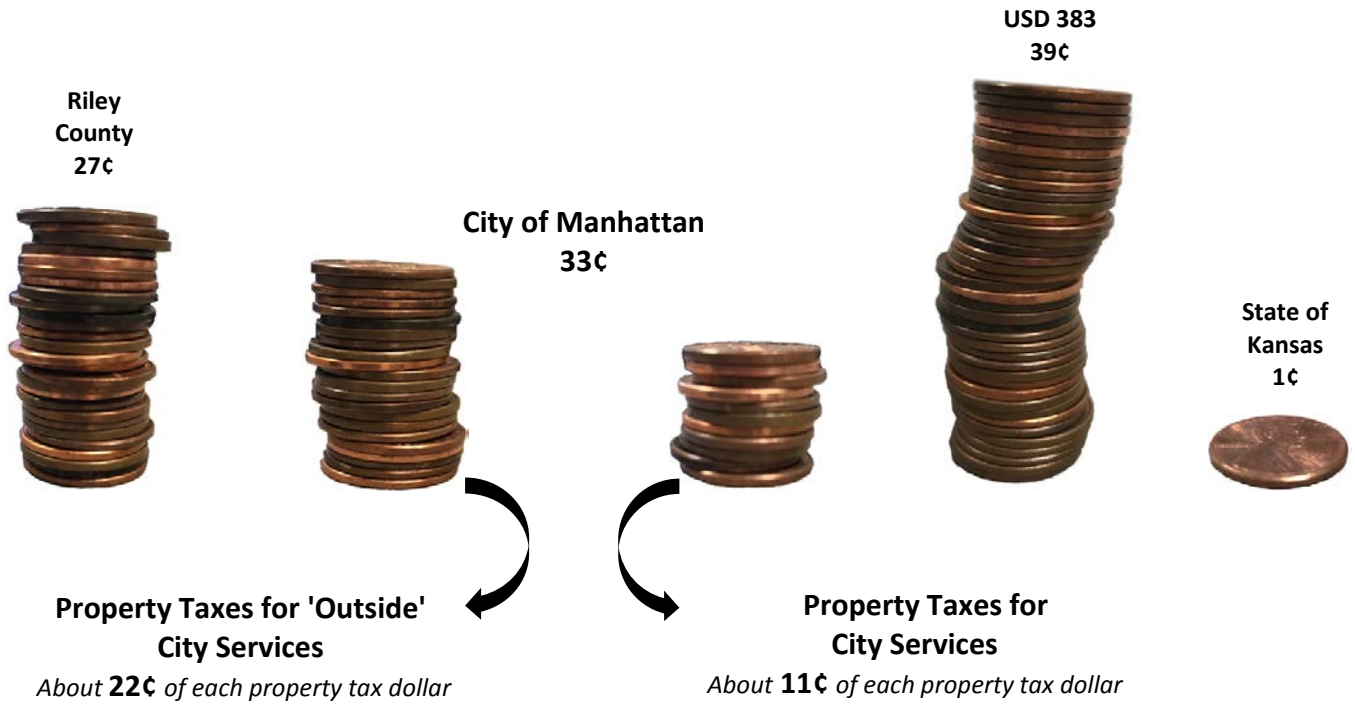


The 2018 Allocation of a Property Tax Dollar

The mill levy rate for the City of Manhattan is 48.357 and is distributed as follows:

Based on the 2018 City Budget adopted by the City Commission, only 33¢ is attributable to the city for every \$1.00 paid in local property taxes. Of this amount, more than two-thirds (about 22¢) are for services that are not part of day-to-day city operations since they are not under the direct control of the City Manager.

A total of \$27,080,924 was levied in property taxes for the 2018 City Budget. \$8,603,404 of this amount will be used to fund city operations, including debt service. \$18,477,520 will be paid to 'outside' city services that are not under the direct control of the City Manager.
